

## Campsite Rules for the use of gamescomCamp at Cologne's "Jugendpark"

1. The campsite is located in a landscape conservation area. Camping is permitted only on those spots explicitly marked as campsite. Every camp visitor will be assigned to a grid square on the campsite upon arrival. It is very important to follow the instructions of the supervisors at all times. Camping at the Rhine riverbank or underneath treetops is prohibited.
2. The tent size must not exceed 2 square meters inner tent space per person. Of course, the 2 square meters per person will be added in a tent depending on the size of the tent and the number of people. So you can certainly bring a tent, which for example has 6 square meters, if 3 people will sleep in it. The construction of awnings, additional tents and the like are only allowed after prior agreement with the camp team.
3. **Departure** must take place by **12 pm (noon)** at the latest. Please make sure to start taking down your tent early enough. Staying on the campsite after 12 pm will be considered as an additional day incurring additional cost. On Monday 29<sup>th</sup> of August 2022, you can stay at the gamescomCamp until 12pm.
4. The organizers cannot be held liable for tents, camping equipment or any other additional objects brought to the campsite. Camp visitors are responsible to carry their valuables with them or lock them securely. There are coin-operated lockers available outside near the check-in. A luggage storage facility is available on the fair grounds.
5. The "Jugendpark" premises and all of its facilities must be treated with care. Every camp visitor will be held liable for culpable personal injury, damage to the campsite and/or facilities around it. All damages must be reported to the supervisors immediately.
6. Campers must set up their tents in such manner to avoid obstruction towards other campsite users. To show adequate respect to other campers, the campsite, all tracks and paths as well as all immediate surroundings should be kept clean and tidy at all times. Upon departure, every campsite user is obliged to ensure that the campsite is left in proper condition. Otherwise, the organizer is entitled to fix all damages at the expense of the user. For each tent, every group has to pay a garbage deposit fee of 5 € in return for a garbage bag and a coupon. We will refund the deposit when you hand over your entire trash including the coupon on the day of your departure.
7. **Between 10pm and 7am all campsite users must keep quiet. Instructions of supervisors and security personnel have to be followed at all times. In case of disregard of repeated warnings, the organizers reserve the right of exclusion from the campsite.** During this time you're not allowed to play electronically amplified music. Bringing your own power generator is generally prohibited! Further, any type of motor vehicles must not be parked at the campsite. Dogs are also not allowed at the gamescomCamp.
8. You're only permitted to barbecue on designated areas if you bring an adequate grill with supporting feet. After your barbecue, you must dispose of the remaining charcoal at the provided waste containers near the entrance. Due to security reasons the use of single-serving grills or the sparking of fire on the lawn is prohibited. Any kind of activity that might damage the lawn is to be omitted. However, in the community area there is a fireplace where we can start a fire every evening.
9. **Only the use of camping gas cylinders is permitted but limited to 0.5 liters per person and stay. Never leave gas cylinder unattended when in use!**
10. Due to strong current, swimming at the Rhine riverbank is perilous and strictly prohibited.
